

WHAT WE'VE BEEN WORKING ON

This year, the Labour Market Group of Renfrew and Lanark partnered with CAPSA to deliver a two part, evidence based workshop series led by clinician and educator Shawn Fisk. Held in Renfrew and Lanark counties, the sessions supported employers, service providers, and community partners in strengthening compassionate, stigma informed approaches in their daily work.

By focusing on reducing stigma, preventing burnout, and building resilience, the workshops provided practical tools to help organizations better support staff and clients, contributing to healthier workplaces and more inclusive services across the region.



The Labour Market Group attended the Rooted in Resilience Economic Development Summit in Pembroke, organized by the County of Renfrew and Renfrew County Community Futures Development Corporation. Allison Miller moderated a panel discussing workforce attraction and retention, sharing strategies to foster strong workplace cultures and retain talent in the region.

COMMUNITY PROFILE: MONTAGUE TOWNSHIP

Montague Township is a welcoming rural community in the southeast corner of Lanark County, offering a peaceful way of life alongside strong regional connections. Bordered by the historic Rideau Canal and situated between Smiths Falls and Ottawa, the township blends agricultural roots, scenic waterways, and easy access to nearby urban centres. The Village of Numogate and the hamlets of Nolans Corners, Rosedale, and Kilmarnock form the heart of this close-knit community.

Home to 3,914 residents (2021 Census), Montague has experienced steady growth while maintaining the open space and low population density that define its rural character. Many residents commute to Smiths Falls and Ottawa for work, allowing families to enjoy a quieter lifestyle without losing access to employment, education, and essential services. Median after-tax household income reached \$85,000 in 2020, reflecting growing economic stability within the community.

Montague's location is one of its greatest strengths. The township is approximately 70 kilometres west of Ottawa and 60 kilometres north of Brockville, with convenient access via Roger Stevens Drive. Three Rideau Canal lock stations and scenic canal frontage support tourism, recreation, and seasonal activity, drawing both residents and visitors to the area. Local businesses are at the heart of Montague's identity. Family-owned farms, food producers, garden centres, artisans, and specialty manufacturers contribute to the local economy and foster a strong sense of community pride.

These enterprises are complemented by employment in construction, health services, automotive businesses, public safety, and municipal services.

Looking ahead, Montague continues to plan thoughtfully for future growth, with a focus on community amenities, recreation opportunities, and keeping the rural character that residents value. Together, these qualities make Montague Township a place where people can live, work, and connect, rooted in tradition while looking to the future.





Montague Township - Community Snapshot (2021 Census)


Population Overview

Total population Montague Vs. Lanark




Population change (2016 → 2021)

Labour Market Update Fall 2025

Job Posting Summary - Lanark County

From September to November 2025, Lanark County saw sustained hiring activity with over 1,000 unique job ads from nearly 500 employers, many reposted due to ongoing hiring needs. The median wage was around \$25.50/hour, mainly in service, care, and customer-facing roles. Demand was strongest in healthcare, retail, food services, and customer service, with top roles including nurses, personal support workers, retail staff, cooks, and food attendants. Overall, the labour market remains active yet tight, as employers continue to recruit for essential and frontline positions.





Regional Distribution of Job Postings




Distribution of Employers Competing by County

These Charts Are Based on Unique Job Postings & Share of Employers by County






HIGHEST RANKED INDUSTRY




These graphs display the highest-ranked industries based on workplace status at the 5-digit NOCS classification in Renfrew and Lanark counties.








These graphs illustrate the fastest-growing occupations based on place of work status, following the 5-digit NOCS classification for Renfrew and Lanark counties.



